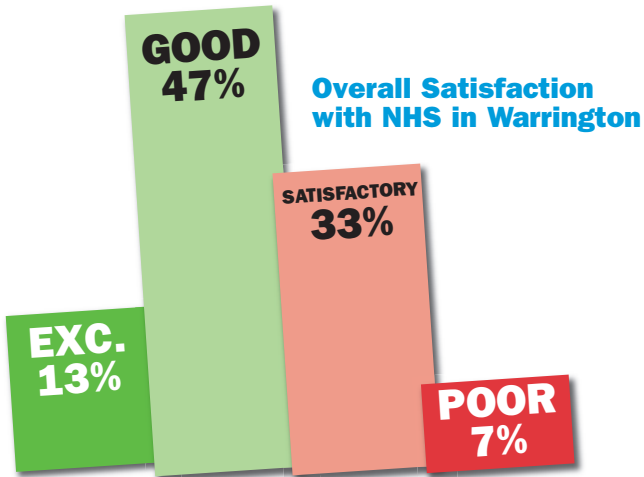


WARRINGTON SOUTH HEALTH SURVEY RESULTS 2009

The survey was sent to around 30,000 households across Warrington and we have received almost 3000 responses. The results are summarized in this leaflet and provide a snapshot on what is going well and those areas where more difficulties are being experienced (dentistry, ease of GP appointments and family planning availability).

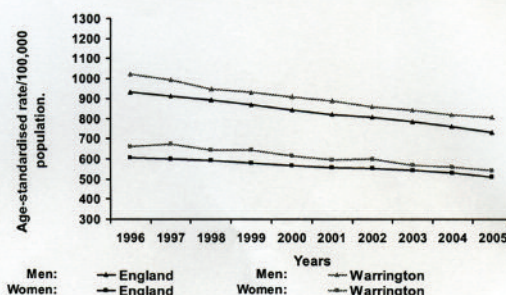
We have also included data on actual healthcare outcomes in Warrington taken from published NHS statistics. These provide an insight into how Warrington compares with the England average on a variety of key measures.

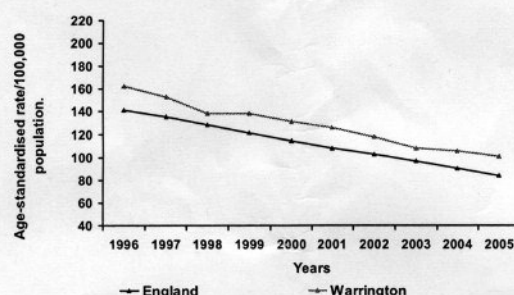
