**ACTION ON JOBS**

**AS THE RECESSION continues to take its toll, unemployment in Warrington has now risen to over 6,000.**

Many of those made redundant have not had to go through the process of applying for work or building the networks which are such an important part of getting back into work for many years.

That is why David Mowat, working with local Conservative volunteers drawn from a variety of business backgrounds, has started a Jobs Club which takes place in Latchford for three hours every Saturday morning.

David explains: 'Our aim is to assist in building CV and interview skills. We also help participants develop the networks which can be a large part of actually getting a job. The first time we ran the course over



50 per cent of those that took part got back into work or full time training – we are very proud of that.'

**HEALTHCARE SURVEY REVEALS DENTISTRY CRISIS IN TOWN**

**OVER THE SUMMER, David Mowat sent NHS and Childcare surveys to over 30,000 homes across Warrington. Over 3,000 replies were received, covering every ward in the town.**

The overall results were very positive, with the majority of residents pleased with the service they receive from both the hospital and GPs.

However, a range of specific issues were identified which varied from individual lapses to more serious incidences of systematic failure. Two areas of concern that were raised repeatedly were the provision of NHS dentistry services – in which over 50 per cent of respondents were having difficulty or finding it impossible to register with an NHS dentist – and family planning, where many people



also had difficulty accessing support. David has discussed the detailed results with NHS managers from both the Primary Care Trust and the Hospital.

'While the majority are pleased with the service they receive areas of weakness do exist that need to be addressed,' he said.
